Identify characteristics of the fiction genre		
• Characters		
• Setting (where the story takes place)		
• Problem

• Plot (Beginning, Middle, End)		
Use one feeling word to identify how character felt at beginning of story.		
• Negative- Sad, Unhappy, etc...		
Use one feeling word to identify how character felt at end of story.		
• Positive – happy, glad, relieved, etc...		
Identify and use specific details from passage to explain how character's feelings changed from beginning of story to the end of the story.		
• Cite paragraph where I found the detail or example		
• Copy the detail directly from the text		
Describe the feelings a character has about doing a specific action.		
Use one word to identify the main characters personality/character trait.		
• Positive – Nice, Friendly		
• Negative – Mean, Bully		
Identify and rewrite specific details from the text to support what character does for me to synthesize this character/personality trait		
• Cite paragraph where I found the detail or example		
• Copy the detail directly from the text		
Explain how one character is a good/bad friend to another character using specific details from the text.		
Tell what a character does to help another character.		
Describe a character's actions.		
Explain what the characters actions tell/show me as a reader about the character's personality or character trait.		
Cite and explain what each action given tells about another character.		
Explain what the setting of the story is using time, location, furniture, and weather clues.

Identify the main character's problem and the things or actions the character does to solve this problem.		
Identify the lesson that the main character learns.		
Identify actions of another character that cause either positive or negative reactions in another character.		
Use specific details from the passage to explain how the characters are alike.		
Use specific details from the passage to explain how the characters are different.		
Explain what causes a character to respond or react by identifying the other characters' effects.		
Identify or explain what the character learns at the end of the story.		
Identify or explain the challenges the main character faced.		
Identify the main idea or author's message.
